KEY Homeschool Association Inc. will test in February and/or March. It evaluates students at various grade levels in the following areas. The cost of the TEST is \$55.00 per CHILD.

The Stanford Achievement Test Series, The Stanford 10 (SAT 10) multiple-choice assessment will help educators find out what students know and are able to do. This technically excellent instrument provides the valid and reliable tool needed for objective measurement of achievement. Grade 4 and up can use a calculator on a portion of the math test.

Areas tested:

Listening (K5-gr. 8)
Spelling (gr. 1-12)
Word analysis (K5-gr. 2)
Mathematics (K5-gr. 12)
Reading skills/comprehension (K5-gr. 12)
Vocabulary (gr. 2-12)
Study skills (gr. 4-12)
Social science/Science (K5-gr. 12)
Language mechanics and usage (gr. 1-12)

Stanford results provide:

Scaled, percentile, grade equivalent scores, achievement percentiles graphed, content cluster skills evaluations, skills performance rating.

KEY Homeschool Association Inc. will also be hosting the OLSAT (Otis-Lennon School Ability Test) the costs of the two Tests are \$70.00 per CHILD.

The Otis-Lennon School Ability Test, the OLSAT will assess developed reasoning and problem-solving abilities important for learning. When the combination tests are given, the results will allow the parent/teacher to compare the student's ability with his actual school achievement. Combined testing is recommended once about every 2-3 years. The approximate testing time is 1 hour for the OLSAT.

Areas tested: Listening, Mathematics, Language mechanics and usage, Reading skills/Comprehension, Social science/Science, Study skills, Spelling, Vocabulary, Word analysis, Verbal comprehension and verbal reasoning (OLSAT), Figural reasoning and quantitative reasoning (OLSAT)

Approximate testing time for complete Stanford battery:

- 4 hours over 2 days for K5
- 6 hours over 3 days for grades 1-3
- 6 hours over 3 days for grades 4-6
- 6 hours over 3 days for grades 7-8
- 4 hours over 2 days for grades 9-12
